CONDITION AND DECLARATION

1. Judging and display of vehicles will take place on Saturday 4th May at the Kerrabee Sound Shell, 4 Blair Street, Moama
2. Vehicles to be formally judged must be present by 8AM
3. Vehicles arriving after 8AM but before 9AM will only be eligible for the Touring category
4. Judges' decisions are final
5. Awards will only be presented to winning vehicles that comply with event conditions
6. **An approved fire extinguisher of 1kg, minimum, is MANDATORY for each vehicle**
7. BATTERY: Must be ISOLATED/DISCONNECTED while on display
8. All vehicles to be displayed must be on site by 9AM
9. Vehicles are to remain in place until 2.00PM. Should there be an emergency, you should follow directions of officiating staff. Vehicles will be escorted from the venue if safe
10. Vehicles travelling on dealer trade plates will not be allowed entry to the event

Declaration: I declare to abide by the regulations and rules outlined by the Early Ford V8 Club of Vic Inc. and its officiating officers. I agree to abide by all road and traffic laws and regulations. I certify that all vehicles under my care meet the necessary safety standards outlined in a roadworthy (safety certificate) and they are legally registered. I declare that I, or any person I wish to nominate to drive this vehicle, hold a current driver's license. In addition, I accept sole and complete responsibility for my own self, property and belongings while travelling to, from or while attending the Early Ford V8 Nationals - Echuca. I accept and understand that it is my responsibility to ensure all my possessions, both material and superficial, are insured from harm, damage, or theft and that it is my personal decision what level of insurance I undertake.
